



Financial Stewardship and Debt Update

We currently have an outstanding balance of \$120,000 on our line of credit. Please know that we are working diligently to manage this debt, and we continue to seek wise counsel and discernment in how to best address this issue moving forward. Your continued prayers and financial support during this season are greatly appreciated.

Transition and Leadership Search

As many of you know, the departure process has now been finalized, and we have received the deeds from the South Georgia Conference. This significant milestone paves the way for us to move forward with the next steps in our church's leadership transition.

In light of this, a committee will be recommended and presented to the Administrative Council to begin the search for a potential pastor. This will include the identification of at least an interim pastor to help guide us through this time of change. The official search will then commence, as we trust that God will bring the right leader at the right time.

We want to reassure you that our committees will continue to provide the same unwavering leadership, ensuring continuity and stability during this time of transition.

Statement of Faith

In addition, we have worked diligently on preparing a Statement of Faith for our congregation. This document is now ready and will be presented to the Administrative Council for a vote. This statement will serve as a cornerstone of our identity and a reflection of the core beliefs that unite us as a church.

Safe Sanctuary Training

As part of our ongoing commitment to safety and well-being, we will be reintroducing Safe Sanctuary training. This training will ensure that our church continues to provide a secure environment for all, particularly our children and vulnerable members. Please stay tuned for upcoming details about this important initiative.

Thank You for Your Support

A special thank you to all who assisted with preparations for the departure walk-through. Your dedication and hard work have been invaluable in ensuring that this transition is as smooth as possible.

Parsonage Decision

A decision regarding the future of the parsonage has not yet been made. We were awaiting the receipt of the deeds, which we have now received. The Trustees will be meeting soon to propose a recommendation on the direction we should take with the property, and we will communicate their decision as soon as it has been finalized.

Ministry and Outreach

Despite the changes, our church has not changed in its mission. We are still faithfully serving our community through various ministries and outreach programs. We continue to offer a wide range of programs for all ages and backgrounds, and we are excited to announce that we are adding new programs designed to meet the growing needs of our congregation and our community.
